Dear Friends,

Welcome to the 2018 summer issue of Villa Voices. As we look back at all that happened in 2017 and early 2018, I am pleased to say that we have accomplished much in that span and look forward to the rest of the year—especially springtime and summertime when we show off our beautiful landscaped yard and gardens. We are most grateful to the First Catholic Slovak Ladies Association (FCSLA) for their loving support of our annual John Hands Day event. The FCSLA provides funds and volunteers who help plant flowers to bring even more beauty to our grounds.

In the front yard, the Holy Family Statue was refurbished thanks to a donation from author and newspaper columnist, Regina Brett and family. The statue will receive a new garden as a result of a donation to the Villa from the Bulone family, in memory of their mother and former resident, Violet Bulone. Another special garden will be planted in the back patio, dedicated to our volunteers. This garden is supported by a donation from the Pannetti family in memory of their mother and former resident Ethel Szabo. A special thank you to Jim Funai, assistant professor of plant science and landscape technology at Cuyahoga Community College Eastern Campus and his students for submitting the two garden designs.

We also completed a number of capital improvement projects. Six apartments received a total makeover and new seating was added in a number of places throughout the building. We have new flooring, lighting and paint in the dining room, private dining room and grand parlor. The dietary manager's office was also refurbished. On the administrative side, Dennis Koher received his RN license and Kieran Patton joined our staff as director of admissions and marketing. We added three new members to our operations team and said goodbye to three members. Lastly, we bid a fond farewell to Dennis Giangiacomo, director of facilities, who has been with the Villa for eight plus years and is retiring in July. Residents, families and staff will gather for a farewell reception. While Dennis will be missed by all, we will welcome John Ivan as the new director of facilities.

We were blessed with fundraising efforts that exceeded \$240,000 thanks to our generous benefactors. This included grants from the SC Ministry Foundation, Sister Elise Grant to support chapel music and the Sisters of Charity Foundation of Cleveland, Saint Ann Legacy Grant, to support our pastoral department and also our Seton Safety Net food closet program. We are truly grateful for these blessings and I am thankful to everyone who believes in our mission.

An Unexpected Ministry By Sister Mary Ann Flannery, SC

ne spring morning, five years ago, Sister Helen Therese Scasny, SC, [former executive director at Light of Hearts Villa] made an announcement at breakfast.

"I'm going to become a beekeeper."

We were incredulous. "That's a lot of work, Helen."

"I know but I met a man at Light of Hearts Villa who was telling me how wonderful it is to raise bees. And, I have read that bees are on the decline and this is catastrophic for the environment. I can do my part to help," she said.

Ross Oriti, the beekeeper she met, began teaching

Sr. Helen the rudiments of beekeeping. Ross was retiring from the business of beekeeping and donated his supplies and equipment to Sr. Helen, and spent the summer training her.

A fellow beekeeper in town, Jim Hensley, learned of Sr. Helen's initiative and the two joined efforts in helping each other. On warm spring and summer days, Sr. Helen and Jim don their protective suits and work on the four hives she has at her home in Bedford, checking for production, providing water and noting any concerns.

"Bees are industrious and clever," explained Sr. Helen, "they usually solve their own problems."

Sr. Helen and Jim usually harvest honey in early summer and late fall, at the beginning of floral blooms and when they begin to fade. Harvesting honey is a major project. Once removed from the combs of the hives, it is placed in a large extractor to sift debris and impurities such as wax, pollen, propolis, and even bee wings and legs. This process takes place in the barn where jars are arranged to capture the honey. In addition to honey, Sr. Helen has created wax items for sale, like small wax candles.

Selling the honey happens at Light of Hearts Villa and other venues where Sr. Helen is asked to speak on beekeeping. Proceeds go to the Villa for the Sr. Helen Scasny, SC, Benevolent Fund, which assists residents who have outlived their financial recourses.

The lives of bees have been a constant source of intrigue for many writers, including dissertations written on the bee imagery so prolific in Emily Dickinson poetry. But for Sr. Helen, at age 85, the message is simple: "I respect what my bees can



teach me. They are among the guardians of the environment and I love learning from them every day. They are remarkable creatures of God and I love telling people that."

As a visitor timidly approaches the hives to observe the work in progress, a line from Dickinson's poem, "The Bumble of a Bee," seems appropriate: "If anybody sneer,

Take care—for God is here—".

Where the Heart Feels at Home

L'Arche means "The Ark." God seemingly has a sense of humor when he directs Noah to gather two of every known animal for the unknown journey that Noah will have to navigate. Today, society places great emphasis on power, advantage, authority and a "better than" attitude that is the opposite of navigating with great diversity. In the Cleveland area and around the world, L'Arche is a social services organization that ministers to persons with developmental disabilities and counters the prevailing norm.

Sister Anita Maroun, SC, is the eastern U.S. regional leader for L'Arche USA. Sr. Anita, who previously was a teacher at Lumen Cordium High School (which now houses Light of Hearts Villa), has been connected with the organization since 1972 when she met the founder of L'Arche in Cleveland. Not long after, she became the board president of the recently formed L'Arche community in Cleveland.

L'Arche celebrates the unique value of every person and recognizes the human need of one for another. Today, L'Arche has 151 communities in 37 countries and 14 projects-groups in the founding process.

Sr. Anita is enthusiastic as she describes the organization's mission. "L'Arche communities are made up of people with and without developmental disabilities, sharing life in communities that belong to an international federation. We share community life through a wide network of mutual relationships, united in the same mission and spirit. Our large international family is located throughout the world and it calls us to solidarity with our world's brothers and sisters and to welcome diversity."

As the eastern U.S. regional leader, Sr. Anita logs many travel miles crisscrossing much of the Eastern United States by car and plane.

"A primary difference from other homes serving the same population is that relationships between the

caregivers and the residents are what L'Arche is about," she said. "It is our belief that it is in these relationships that we are transformed—that we become more human and enable others to become more human."

"L'Arche is the place where my heart feels most at home," Sr. Anita added.
